

NOTE TO PARENTS

The Youth Staff and I are excited to begin a “New Year” in the teen group. The summer has been exciting, but we are geared up and ready for the coming ministry year. This year your teen will have many opportunities to grow closer to Christ by being involved with the Teen Ministry here at Monclova Road Baptist Church. We realize that your teen needs YOUR support, encouragement and example to grow spiritually and stand for the faith. Will you be a Godly example this year and encourage your teenager to be personally involved in ministry through the teen group here at MRBC?

Our theme for the 2009-10 year is “The Church, It’s Allies and Enemies.” Each Wednesday Night, your teen will be learning about these important doctrines from the Word of God. This year, because of space issues, we will be keeping the 8:53 group (7th-9th) and the 11:50 group (10th-12th) completely separate on Wednesday nights. Mr. Chad DeFriece and I will be co-teaching both 8:53 and the 11:50. Occasionally, Mr. Adam Parrot, Mr. Nathan Stec, Mr. Steve Fry, and Mr. Chris Shepherd will be doing some teaching. Also, in an attempt to provide continuous opportunities for preaching, several of our teens will take on teaching roles on Wednesday Night as well.

Each Sunday morning, our entire teen group will meet together for songs and announcements at 9:30a. After the opening exercises, we will move to separate Sunday school classes designed for age-appropriate learning: 8:53 girls; taught by Mrs. Sue Page and Mrs. Bonita Jackson; 8:53 guys; taught by Mr. Steve Fry; 11:50 girls; taught by Mrs. Tatianne O’Bradovic; and 11:50 guys; taught by Pastor Paul.

Our Sunday school classes will be focusing on a series called “Life Step: Connecting Walk and Worship.” Each lesson taught will be derived from the weekly Quiet Time that we encourage all of our teens to purchase.

We hope you realize that we have your teen’s best interests at heart and desire for them to grow in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Our desire is to come along side of you as a parent and help instruct, guide, discipline and love your teenager. Please know that throughout the year, our youth staff will be praying for you and your teen to be more like Christ.

11:50 Puppet Team

The 11:50 Puppet Team is under the direction of Mrs. Linda Clark. Practice is on Sunday afternoon at 5:00p unless otherwise indicated in the Teen Connection. All teens are encouraged to join a puppet team. The number of teams will be based on the number of teens that show up for practice. If a teen joins a team, he is expected to remain on that team until the skit has been used in ministry. Any teen that joins a Teens Involved Skit, will be expected to participate in that skit throughout the highest level of T.I. for that given year. (In 2010, the highest level will be REGIONALS in Columbus, Ohio.)

8:53 Puppet Team

The 8:53 Puppet Team is under the direction of Pastor Paul. Practice is on Sunday afternoon at 5:00p unless otherwise indicated in the Teen Connection. All teens are encouraged to join a puppet team. The number of teams will be based on the number of teens that show up for practice. If a teen joins a team, he is expected to remain on that team until the skit has been used in ministry. Any teen that joins a Teens Involved Skit, will be expected to participate in that skit throughout the highest level of T.I. for that given year. (In 2010, the highest level will be REGIONALS in Columbus, Ohio.)



Kazoo 4 You

Kazoo 4 You is under the direction of Pastor Paul. Practice is on Sunday morning immediately following Sunday school for FIVE MINUTES. (Approximately 10:35-10:40a) unless otherwise indicated in the Teen Connection. All teens are encouraged to join Kazoo 4 You. The Kazoo team commitment level is on a song-to-song basis. If a teen joins a team for a specific song, he is expected to remain on that team until that song has been used in ministry. Any teen that joins for the Teens Involved Song, will be expected to participate in that song throughout the highest level of T.I. for that given year. (In 2010, the highest level will be REGIONALS in Columbus, Ohio.)



Drama and Video Team

With the popularity of web sites like YouTube, the ability to broadcast oneself is becoming more popular and common. Sometimes just telling someone the truth does not have as big of an impact as seeing the truth displayed on a screen. The MRBC Drama/Video Team is designed to use the mediums of Drama and Video to display the truths of the Word of God in a creative and appealing way. In the past, the MRBC Teens have designed three different videos designed to be used as a sermon introduction. All three videos were created as Teens Involved events. This year, we would like to see the teens use drama and video on a more consistent basis. The team has two work days scheduled for filming and editing. (October 26th and December 7th). More work days will be scheduled as the team forms. All teens are eligible to join the Video/Drama Team. Anyone with a desire to join the team, needs to sign-up by September 27, 2009.

Ministry Opportunities

Teen Choir - Endless Praise

Endless Praise is under the direction of Pastor Dan DeFriece. Practice is in the teen room for no more than THIRTY minutes on Wednesday evenings immediately following the Teen Service (Approximately 8:20-8:50p) unless otherwise indicated in the Teen Connection. All teens are encouraged to join Endless Praise. The commitment level for Endless Praise is yearly. We ask that ALL teens who participate in Teens Involved to join Endless Praise for TWO songs. (One that will be referred to as "Teen Choir" and the other that will be referred to as "Instrumental Group.")

Quiz Team

The 2 Timothy 3:16 passage says "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." There is nothing more valuable than studying God's Word. Quizzing is an excellent way to study the Biblical principles taught through the *Student Lifeline Series*. As the students study, they will be able to more readily apply the Scriptures to their lives and grow in their walk with the Lord. The Quiz Blitz Team is asked to STUDY the material from the Lifeline Manual and the Wednesday Evening messages in an in-depth way, memorize key passages of Scripture, and focus on how these truths apply to their lives. They are quizzed on this material in Area and Regional Competition with Quiz Teams from other churches in Ohio and West Virginia.

Quiz Blitz is a Teens Involved style of quizzing where every quizzer's response counts for every multiple-choice question. Each quizzer uses an "X-Box" controller to respond to the question. The level of commitment for Quizzing is high. Each teen must study on his own and be prepared for quiz competition. All Quiz Blitz members are expected to attend the Quiz Retreat on October 31, 2009 in Troy, Ohio, the Area Quiz Competition on March 12, 2009, Regional Quizzing on April 23, 2009, and any scheduled practices (Scheduled as needed; usually on a Thursday Night or Sunday afternoon; approximately 6 times a year). All teens are eligible for Quizzing and are encouraged to join the team. Anyone who would like to join the Quiz Team should sign-up by September 27, 2009. See Pastor Paul for Quizzing information after this date.

Teens Involved

Principle: 1 Peter 4:10; Romans 12:11; 1 Corinthians 4:1-2; 1 Corinthians 12:4; Colossians 3:23-24.

Philosophy: "Since God has given every believer gifts, talents, and abilities to serve Him for His glory, we need to lead, help, and encourage youth to find and use them for this purpose."

Purpose: "Encourage and help Christian teenagers gain experience in presenting their gifts and abilities to God for His honor, glory and service."

Program: "Students may choose from 21 categories of involvement for either Sr. High or Junior High."

People: Discover gifts, talents and abilities; enjoy fellowship with other teens; experience new avenues of ministry.

Why we do what we do

WOL Quiet Time and Lifelines Manual

The MRBC Teen Group promotes and encourages all teens to purchase a yearly Lifelines Manual. The Manual is produced by Word of Life International and contains a 52 week daily Quiet Time and prayer journal, a Bible reading schedule, 44 weeks of lesson notes for the Wednesday evening messages, a yearly calendar, sermon note pages, a Teens Involved instruction and information guide and the Cre8ive Discipleship reward program. In the past, the Lifelines Manual was connected most strongly to the Wednesday Night events and those who purchased it, on a whole, were more connected to the teen group and to ministry.

This year, we will be using the “Life Steps” Curriculum on Sunday Morning. This curriculum connects the Quiet Time passages to everyday life. Students will be using this Lifelines Manual on both Sunday morning and Wednesday evening. We encourage EVERY teen to purchase and USE the WOL Quiet Time. Quiet Times for both elementary aged children and adults are available for purchase from the MRBC Teen Ministry. All Quiet Time journals are unified in the passage of Scripture to be read and applied for each day and are laid out in an age-appropriate format.

Scripture Memory Pack

Principle: Psalm 119:11; Psalm 1:2; Joshua 1:8; Colossians 3:16

Philosophy: “Internalizing Scripture to connect to life’s needs and problems is essential for a growing, obedient Christian.”

Purpose: “The systematic memorization of Scripture will help a believer to sin less, witness more, and encourage others.”

Program: The teens will have 24 verses to memorize throughout the year. They will connect with twenty-four of the doctrinal lessons of the year.

People: Sin less, witness more encourage others.

Reading Christian Books

Principle: Philippians 3:17; 2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Corinthians 4:16; Philippians 4:8

Philosophy: “Through the Godly example and exhortation of gifted writers, we are challenged to live Biblically.”

Purpose: “To counteract the media impact of the world and open the heart of a student to a life of Christian service.”

Program: “Read three books—two recommended by Word of Life— and one missionary or Christian biography of your choice.” Word of Life suggested reading books are available in the teen library.

People: Strengthen convictions, become open to missionary service.

Christian Service

Principle: Matthew 28:19; 1 Peter 4:10; Hebrews 10:24; Acts 1:8

Philosophy: “Engraft the Word of God in students’ lives to the point that it is demonstrated in their compassion and care for others.”

Purpose: “Direct and equip students in various avenues of serving God through individual and group evangelistic and service projects.”

Program: “Each student is encouraged to participate in 18 Christian service. They may choose from 23 different individual opportunities and 29 different group opportunities.”

People: Develop a habit of serving God by serving others, sense the joy that comes in Christian service, see students leading others to Christ.

Basic Information

Standard of Dress

Principle: 1 Peter 1:14-16; Romans 12:2

Philosophy: "Our dress should not be patterned after the world, but be holy. We should look differently than the world."

Purpose: "To dress according to a Biblical standard and as far away from a worldly standard as possible."

Program: "The standard for dress in the teen group is 'neck-to-knee.' This protects the teens from conformity to the world and from inappropriate thoughts and/or actions."

People: Our lives are more like Christ, brothers in Christ are not offended or faced with a stumbling block.

Music and Electronic Devices

While we recognize the popularity of i-pod's and music devices among this generation, we request that your teen leave such devices at home while attending MRBC 8:53 or 11:50. While attending our teen service, we desire for your teen to learn from the Word of God, apply the Word of God personally and fellowship with other believers. While attending teen events, we desire for your teen to fellowship with others and exhort one another. Music and electronic devices isolate your teen from the group. Your teen will have more opportunity to participate and be exhorted without his/her music or electronic device.

Teen Connection

Each Sunday morning in Sunday school, the teens may pick up a copy of the "Teen Connection." This weekly announcement sheet is designed to keep teens and parents informed of up coming events on a weekly basis. While most events are listed on the yearly calendar in this book, we recognize the need for additional reminders as the event draws near. The Teen Connection is also used as a source of encouragement and recognition for our teens. The Quotable Quote section is designed to help teens read encouraging quotes from "heroes" of the faith and other prominent people. The Movie Review is designed to inform parents for the content of movies that your teen would possibly desire to watch. The Memory Verse of the Week section is designed to encourage the reader to hide God's Word in his heart.

Ministry Teams

Café Team

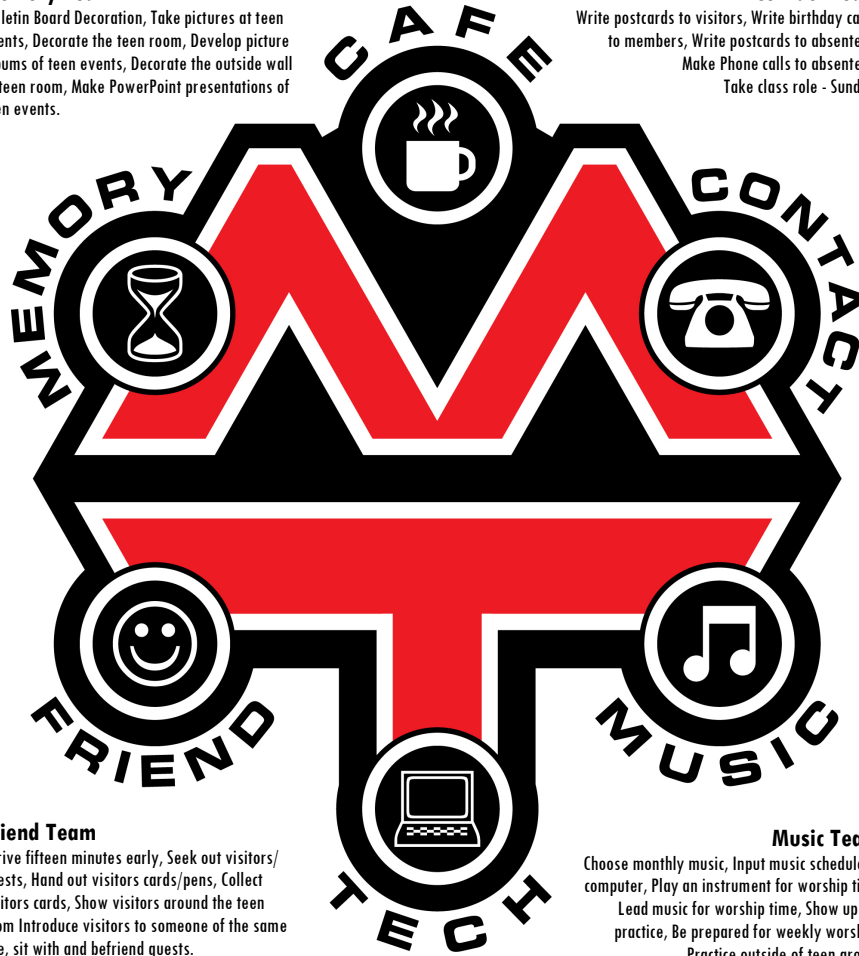
